# **Omicron Pi Foundation**

## **History**

Omicron Pi Foundation (OPF) is a 501 (c) (3) tax exempted corporation which was incorporated January 12, 2015 in the state of Texas. Omicron Pi Foundation came into fruition as a result of the Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc. desire to have a charitable foundation which could provide uplift for the community and constituency that the fraternity serves locally. As a result, the foundation, under direction of Foundation leadership is to establish a relief fund in support of Friends in Crisis Shelter which was closed due to lack of funding. Omicron Pi Foundation, with the support the Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc. and Its membership raised \$28,560.00.

## **Vision**

Omicron Pi Foundation is a viable, non-profit extension of OPF's commitment to improve the lives of People. OPF will expand its member/supporter base and will be recognized throughout Killeen for providing quality programming to at-risk youth, and advocate for education, professional mentoring, job training/referral, disaster relief for the disadvantaged, and support to the elderly and homeless.

## **Mission**

- Establish a partnership with a local organization – LIGHTING THE IGNITION FOR FUTURE ENDEAVORS (L.I.F.E.)
- Provide programs of Uplift to the local homeless and less fortunate community
- Foster programs and activities of economic empowerment in distressed neighborhoods
- Provide Humanitarian Assistance and Disaster relief in times of critical need.

## **Goals**

- Raise \$1M/year for philanthropic purposes;
- Be nationally recognized for expertise in mentoring and academic enrichment programs for the disadvantaged
- Provide technical expertise on capacity building for nonprofit community service groups and allied professional organizations;
- Promote/demonstrate model(s) of economic empowerment for distressed neighborhoods.

# **LIFE**

Killeen, like most cities in the country, has seen an increase in the number of displaced citizens living in its shelters and streets. After taking the time to talk to these individuals and the organizations that assist them, the LIFE Board was formed to help bring services to the individuals that need them most.

## **Mission**

To assist community members in need

## **LIFE will meet the organizational mission through**

- GED classes
- Identification and essential document recovery
- Job preparation via application and resume preparation classes, and interview preparation to include mock interviews and interview appropriate attire
- Computer proficiency
- Counseling services
- Health screening
- Financial literacy and budgeting classes
- Partnering with the community
- Continue to provide all programs at no cost to attendees

## **LIFE's accomplishments as of August 26, 2019**

- Assisted in housing 12 individuals/families
- Secured a short-term use apartment for individuals and families identified for housing with 24-72 hours
- Collected donations of furniture that was used to furnish recently housed individuals and families
- Collected donations of men's and women's business clothes and shoes to be used for job interviews
- Provided interview clothing to 2 displaced individuals and assisted 1 in obtaining a job interview. Both individuals received job offers
- Assisted with the planning, coordination, and implementation of an Informational Block Party for the Displaced and Less Fortunate (DLF)
- Started the process of planning our first workshop offering to the DLF
- Established a community expectation of offering informational events once every 3-4 months for the DLF
- Partnered with two local shelters to provide training workshops in-house
- Partnered with Omicron Pi Foundation (OPF) a 501 (c) (3) organization
  
- Identified a location for GED classes for DLF residents

## **Goals**

- Continue to expand workshop curriculum with the assistance of local organizations
- Identify and secure an exclusive location for LIFE to be used as a day center for DLF residents
- Complete 501(c)3 registration Meet with community partners including members of the DLF community to assess successes and room for improvement, and to determine what most urgent needs are for upcoming workshops and Create a self-sustainable funding mechanism for LIFE
